Session Type

- **Family swim (families only):** For responsible adults with children only. A responsible adult aged 16 years and above must be present in the pool during this session. Free swimming QR codes can be used in these sessions during the school holidays. Children aged 8 years and over are allowed in the learner pool when attending with family during this session.
- **Public swim:** Available to all members of the public. Please note: During the school holidays, children participating in Free Swimming must be accompanied into the centre by a responsible adult aged 18 years and above. The accompanying adult does NOT need to swim unless the child is under 8 years of age. If children aged 8 and over attend the pool unaccompanied by an adult, they may still swim but this will be charged at the standard rate. Free swimming QR codes can be used in this session.
- **Family disability swim:** For people with disabilities, special educational needs, ASD and their families. Free swimming QR codes can be used in this session.
- **Under 5s splash time:** For children under five years of age and parents/carers only. This is a non-instructor led session that takes place in the learner pool. A variety of toys, including watering cans and boats will be available for your child to enjoy. This session is **not included** in free swimming.
